Criteria to apply:

- Applicants must attend a certificate program, vo-tech, 2-year or 4-year program.
 - The applicant must be a current LCHS senior in good standing.
 - The applicant must complete the formal scholarship application form and submit documentation to the LCHS guidance department by March 1st.

If awarded a scholarship:

The scholarship shall be awarded at the annual LCHS Senior Awards Assembly. Awards will be determined annually by a selection committee.
