Class of 1972 Technical Scholarship -\$250 annually-

The Class of 1972 Technical Scholarship is a scholarship that was developed by contributions from the Labette County High School graduating class of 1972. The scholarship has been designated to support a student seeking to develop and enhance trade/vo tech skills.

Criteria to apply:

Applicant(s) must be a current LCHS graduating senior.
Applicant(s) must have plans to attend a vo tech school.
Applicant(s) must have plans to pursue a career in a technical field that does not require a college degree.
Applicant(s) must fill out the formal application and submit to the LCHS guidance office by March 1st.

If awarded the scholarship:

The scholarship shall be awarded at the annual Senior Awards assembly and recognized at the Alumni Banquet

The 506 Foundation shall, with any input offered by the donor(s), select the appropriate committee of not less than three members to determine the recipient(s) of the scholarship. Their decision shall be final.

Recipient selection will be based on the following:

- Financial Need
- Area of Study
- Community Involvement

Scholarship payment shall be made to the recipient and the vo tech school when evidence of enrollment, attendance, and payment of fees has been presented to the 506 Foundation Treasurer located at the USD 506 District Office.

Failure to claim the scholarship awarded by November 1 of the award year will render the scholarship offer null and void.
