football field with a check for \$500.00.

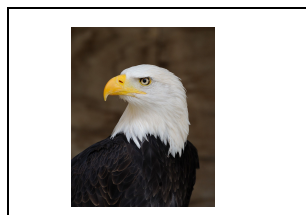
Mrs. Vanderford was nominated for her desire to "reach all learners".
