Science - 6th Grade started a new unit when we returned from Christmas break in a new text book: *Earth's Surface*. Our first chapter is about Earth's interacting spheres: Atmosphere, Biosphere, Geosphere, and Hydrosphere. Students will begin a Brochure Project this week with facts and information highlighting each Sphere and how it interacts with the other spheres.
