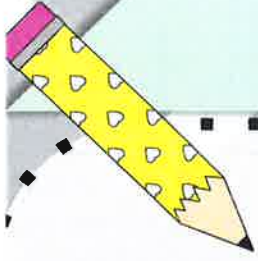


Mrs. Heflin's 5th Grade News



We are learning:

Language Arts: In reading groups, we are learning about author's purpose, story structure, and fact and opinion. In grammar, we are learning about adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, and prepositional phrases. We will also start an opinion writing piece this month. Students are also being assigned IXL to complete each week.

Math: In Math, we are diving head first into fractions. We will work on adding and subtracting them, mostly with unlike denominators. We are also still practicing our math facts through CWPT. Please continue helping your child learn his/her math facts. You can use flashcards, counting money, or games. Students also have math IXL to complete each week.

Science: We are working through a unit about how organisms interact and their relationships. We will also be talking about energy and matter in ecosystems.

Social Studies: We are focusing on landforms, how to differentiate between states, countries, and continents, and our local regions.
