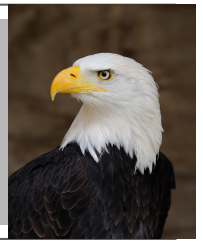

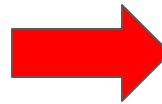
### Summer Weight Lifting Opportunity.

## **8th Grade Boys Break AGS Track Records:**

The 506 invitational was held last Thursday on April 14th when the record-breaking began in the long jump pit with Barrett Hestand. With a mark of 18 ft 1 3/4 he passed the previous distance of 18 ft 1 set in 2010 by Caleb Carson. The Sprint Medley Relay Team also broke a record at the 506 invitational with a time of 1:51.05. Conner Hanigan, Jamaal Jackson, Kegan Bates, and Isaiah Rosenberg broke the previous record of 1:51.4, set in 2011 by Eli Tallman-Clark, Dominique Johnson, George Langston, and Destry Lunsford.

Isaiah Rosenberg competed in the Columbus track meet on Monday, April 18th where he broke his second and third school record of the season as an Altamont Eagle.

The previous record-holder for the 100 Meter Dash was Dominique Johnson with a time of 11.72 in 2012. Rosenberg's time was 11:68.

The 400 Meter Dash record was held by Caleb Hartman since 1999 whose time was 56.3 seconds. Rosenberg's time on Monday was 55:96.
