If a student or staff member has been identified as a close contact, they are able to be tested daily at their school building for the duration of their 10 day quarantine period. ## Altamont Grade School




Principal Flatt reported 92% attendance at "Meet the Teacher Night" on Wed. Aug. 25. It was so great to see all of our families back at school!!
