The skill we are practicing in math is addition. We will spend a lot of time on this concept. Working on numbers to 100 will also be a

focus for us. This will be recognizing, counting by ones and tens, and writing.

Our P.E. and Music days have switched for this second part of the year. We will have Music on M-W-F and P.E. on Tues. and Thurs. of each week.

My expectations of behavior and following directions are higher now. The behavior cards will be changing with less reminders than the first semester. We are getting ready for first grade.
