We should be able to name, describe, draw, and create all five shapes taught (circle, square, triangle, rectangle, and hexagon). Then, our next chapter will be 3-D shapes.
- Some of the reading skills we are working on, are reading three to five letter words along with nonsense words. Also, reviewing all 40 pre-primer sight words and learning the primer list, reading comprehension with more retelling, and rhyming (recognize and produce). The class is very busy reading lots of leveled books for reading practice and to help with fluency.
- Grammar has been a focus as we do sentence building and writing activities.

- This month we are working on spring weather for part of our science and reading assignments. We have already done several class experiments.
- We want to finish the year strong and be ready for first grade. Our class will continue to work hard on all old/new skills, and extra hard on any skills that were marked (N) for needs improvement on our grade cards. * I want to say that I am very proud of this class for their hard-working attitudes and putting extra effort into their learning. I will definitely miss working with them next year.
