CURRICULUM

Science- We have been covering lab safety, safety symbols, and practicing routines since the start of school. Sixth grade's first unit is Circulation in Earth's Atmosphere. All 3 science classes will take a Scientific Prefix, Suffix, or Root Word quiz every week starting September 12th. The word list, schedule and practice activities are in their Science Google Classroom. They have a handout on how to access their Google Classroom from home.

Social Studies –Sixth grade studies Ancient World History. Our first topic is Origins of Civilization/Prehistory. We will complete a hands on simulation to open the unit this week. **Novel –** Our first novel that we will be reading and discussing is The Egypt Game. This coincides with our Ancient World History. **Math** – Sixth graders will be starting the year studying Numerical Expressions and Factors. It would be great if you could review multiplication and division at home or in the car. This practice will help when studying greatest common factors and least common multiples as well as other skills. We will have a weekly quiz starting on Thursday, September 14th. The Thursday quizzes will review basic knowledge that will help them throughout the year. Please make sure that your child knows their address and your phone number.

Reading - We will begin our grammar usage and mechanics review next week. This will cover parts of speech, punctuation, capitalization, and sentence structure.
